

CHAPTER 9

OFFENSES AGAINST THE PERSON

SECTION:

11-9-1: ASSAULT:

A person commits an assault when, without lawful authority, he or she engages in conduct which places another in reasonable apprehension of receiving a battery.

11-9-2: BATTERY:

A person commits battery if he or she intentionally or knowingly without legal justification and by any means: (1) causes bodily harm to an individual; or (2) makes physical contact of an insulting or provoking nature with an individual.

11-9-3: RECKLESS CONDUCT:

A person who causes bodily harm to or endangers the bodily safety of an individual by any means, commits reckless conduct if he or she performs recklessly the acts which cause harm or endanger safety, whether they otherwise are lawful or unlawful.

11-9-4: HAZING:

A person commits hazing who knowingly requires the performance of any act by a student or other person in school, college, university, or other educational institution of this State, for the purpose of induction or admission into any group, organization, or society associated or connected with that institution if the act is not sanctioned or authorized by that educational institution.
